## **1. People Who Know You Notice.**

We see the same people at work, or at school, a circle of friends that you hang with. They notice your prayers, your modest clothing, what you do on Sundays. They see how you handle difficult situations. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Even our own family notices. And they will know whether our faith is real or not and how deeply we love the Lord.

## **2. People Who Don't Know You Notice.**

We meet everyday people that we really don't know - at the gas station, post office, UPS truck, the doctor's offices. They see how we handle inconveniences. They see how patient we are. They see how honest we are. They should see us as positively distinctive from the world (IPeter 3:15). A city on a hill cannot be hidden.

## **3. Above all, God Notices You.**

God sees all. "The eyes of the LORD are in every place, watching the evil and the good" (Proverbs 15:3). God "looks upon the heart" (I Samuel 15:7). He cannot be mocked or fooled (Galatians 6:7-9). Nobody can play games with God and win!

A city set upon a hill cannot be hidden. You are noticed! The closer we get to Jesus, the light of the world, the brighter our light will shine! So make sure you're close to Jesus today - because every time you get noticed - **He will.**
