The Love of Jesus

To have the love of Christ is to have something more valuable than silver and gold and precious gems. These are of the earth. "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; because the earth and the works that are therein will be burned up" (2 Pet. 3:10).
