King Hezekiah did and he asked Isaiah for more time (II Kings 20:1). God granted him 15 more years. And yet, there was an end.

There are 6 things I can think of that would be important.

5. Smell the roses.

Take a moment to appreciate everything around you. Psalm 19:1 David wrote - The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament showeth

His handiwork.

6. Obey the Gospel.

Take one of the last moment you have and do this for yourself. Be selfish, it is OK. No one can do this for you and you cannot do this for someone else.

Matthew 7:21 Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven, but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in Heaven.
